Dear Belcarists

We informed you last week that the local government has not given the permission for the organization of the Zolder Superprix on 07-08-09 August. Which is a very regrettable thing for the organizer, all the participating series including the Belcar and last but not least the circuit. In the meantime, we have been able to obtain that we can race only with the Belcar on Sunday 9 August 2020.

We realize it's a late decision, but we really want to start racing and we really hope to see you at the start of the Belcar race this Sunday.

Please communicate us asap the names and email addresses of all your team members – max **8 persons** per car (mechanics, truck driver,...) using the form in attachment. Drivers are not included. We need this information because only registered people are allowed to the domain. Control will be done at the main gate.

We need the information not later than Friday 7<sup>th</sup> August **15:00**. After this date, we cannot add more people on the list!

On arrival at Circuit Zolder, every accredited member of the Belcar community must observe social distancing, wear a face mask and stay in his bubble.

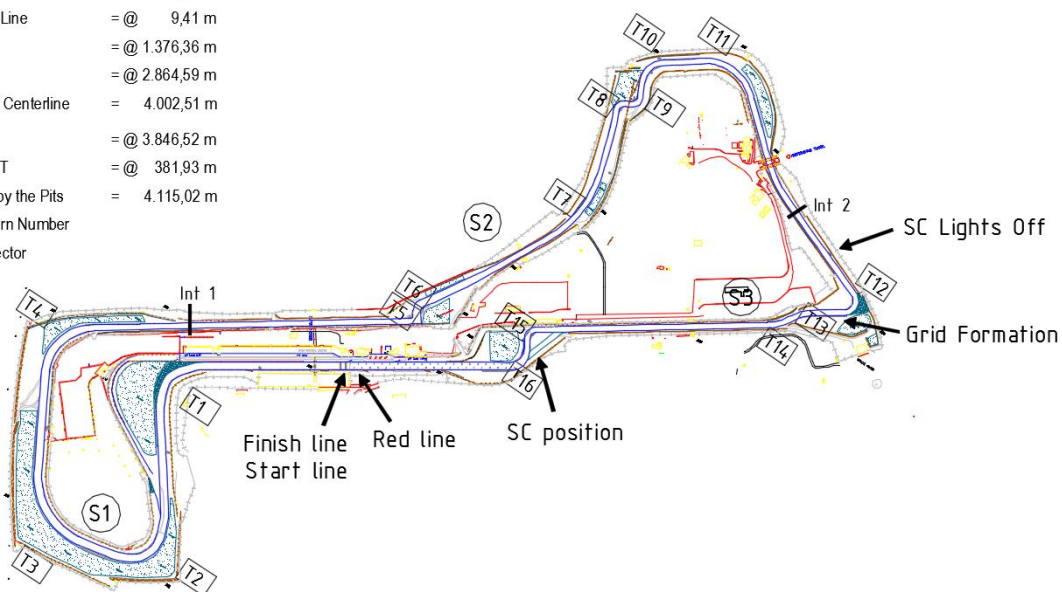
To protect the Belcar community, may we ask you **not to come** to Circuit Zolder if you have Covid19 symptoms.

### **Noise restrictions**

No noise limitation :

Saturday: from 09:00-12:00 and 13:00-18:00

Sunday: from 10:00-18:00

*Before and after the times from beginning and ending there must be a complete motor silence for all competition vehicles. The motor silence is obliged for every car, each breach will be fined with a penalty going on from € 500,00 to even exclusion from the race meeting if this motor silence isn't respected.*

### **There is complete motor silence for cars with combustion engines:**

- until 09:00 on Saturday, 10:00 on Sunday
- between 12:00 and 13:00 on Saturday
- after 18:00 on Saturday and Sunday

*This applies to all race cars, motorbikes, quads and sound equipments.*

*The organizer is submitted to the regulations on music activities as listed in chapters 4.5, 5.32 and 6.7 of the Flemish Environmental Legislation (VLAREM) and article 561 of the Criminal Code concerning noise at night.*

### **Waiting area**

Outside the paddock at the entrance "Parking 69" (where the accreditation center/iwelcome center is situated). No water or electricity available!

### **Accreditation Center / Welcome Center**

Opening hours:

Saturday 08 August 2020: **09:00-12:00**





**Tickets/bracelets and car passes with barcode can be collected in the welcome center.**

The paddock for the Belcar Endurance Championship is in paddock 2 including garages/boxes.

Opening hours paddock for **installation**:

Saturday 8 August 2020: **09:00-12:00**

**No earlier entry to the race track and paddock is allowed!**

Parking of private cars of drivers and crew -> **only in paddock 4.**

#### **Mobilehomes & motorhomes**

Entrance is allowed Saturday 8 August 2020 from 09:00-12:00.

All caravans, mobile homes and motorhomes are allowed to park only at the allocated area, being paddock 1. All caravans, mobile homes and motorhomes parked in this area must have a designated parking ticket of Circuit Zolder.

**The setup of tents (or similar) is strictly prohibited.**

-> Only for teams who have submitted an application to the organization in **advance**.

Application via e-mail must be sent to [herli@belcarseries.com](mailto:herli@belcarseries.com) as soon as possible.

Place reservation is not allowed!

With the start of setup the **whole paddock speed limit of 30km/h** may not be exceeded (except for rescue vehicles in emergency case). Contravention may induce serious penalties up to exclusion of the meeting.

If a vehicle - regardless which kind of vehicle - will not respect the speed limit after its first warning, the parking and access passes will be withdrawn.

Vehicles (racetrucks, race services,...) that have to be parked in the paddock must appear optically perfect and totally clean.

#### **Catering**

Teams are responsible for their own catering.





### **Garages/Boxes**

Garages/boxes are at the disposal of the Belcar teams from Saturday 8 August till Sunday 9 August 2020. No renting will be charged only a deposit of € 100,00 for the key of the garage/box. Keys can be collected at the reception desk of the Control Tower:

Saturday from **09:00-12:30**.

In order to recover the deposit, the key must be brought back on Sunday 9 August before 19:00!

### **Deposit**

#### **Deposit bracelets**

We kindly ask you to pay a deposit of € 200,00 for the use of 3 orange bracelets and 6 green when picking up the bracelets in the Control Tower.





All teams can return their bracelets at the race secretariat in Zolder during the "24 Hours of Zolder" after the Belcar race. If the bracelets are returned in good condition, the deposit will be refunded by bank transfer the week after the 24 Hours, being 9-13 November 2020.

### **Radio Communication**

At least one month before the start of the meeting, each competitor, team leader, driver, team member or their agents and representatives, desiring to use equipment with radio transmission in order to establish a communication between the car and the team, must file in an application to:

### **Radio communication from the Race Director**

All teams will get from the promotor of the Belcar a radio which will be used for communication (one way) with the Race Director in addition to messages given on the screen, written or oral. Teams must be listening to the frequency from 15 minutes before the start of each session till the end of the session (free practice, qualifying and race). Further information will follow during the team manager's briefing.

### **Podium Ceremony**

May we ask you, if you are among the lucky winners, to stay in the near of the podium so that the ceremony for 1-2-3 can start immediately after the race! Because of the Covid19 safety measures only the drivers are allowed to the podium! Wearing a mouth mask is obliged.

### **Leaving Paddock**

Dismantling is only allowed after the end of the race. Teams who have to dismantle after abandon of the race have to require a permission by the clerk of the course. Breaking this rule will be punished by the organizers.
